

A.E.Dor Cognac

Tasting Notes

V.S.O.P , ABV 40%, Aged 8 Years

A blend of Grande and Petite Champagne, matured in humid cellars. Pungent on the nose with a generous floral bouquet, hints of violet and summer fruit. Delicate and smooth on the palate, with a lovely balance which leads to a lingering finish.

Napoleon, ABV 40%, Aged 18 Years

A blend of different growths combining mature Fins Bois eaux-de-vie with the vigour and vivacity of Borderies and the finesse and length of Grande & Petite Champagne. Lovely spicy and vanilla tones on the nose give way to a richer palate with hints of stone fruit and cinnamon. Long, rich and luscious on the finish.

For Cigar, ABV 42%, Aged 18 Years

Grande and Petite Champagne give this remarkable XO its finesse and character. Elegant and full flavoured, this extremely well-balanced Cognac develops consistently from the nose to the palate. Peach and apricot notes on the nose merge with honey and apricot flavours and a hint of spice. All combine beautifully to give a complex, velvety finish.

X.O, ABV 40%, Aged 25 Years

To complement the strength and complexity of cigars this blend is made predominantly of Grande Champagne and has been aged in new barrels to give the Cognac a more tannic edge. This more woody profile and higher ABV content give the Cognac a strong, rich and complex character which will enhance any cigar smoking experience and expand the repertoire of those wishing to learn about this most noble of spirits.
