

Beija-Flor Cachaça

Tasting Notes

Pura

Nose: Luscious clear creamy sugarcane character; slightly oily, with wet hay and cut grass. Faint honeysuckle.

Palate: On the fuller side of medium-weight. Very clean, intense sugar cane, grassy and creamy again, with a velvet mouthfeel. Remarkable depth of flavour for a silver cachaça.

Finish: Lingering residual sweetness and creamy white chocolate.

Velha / 2 Year Old

Nose: Very prominent rich agricole nose of wet hay, gets quite sweet with strong hints of vanilla and faint notes of cocoa powder & praline.

Palate: Mediumweight. Bourbony notes, ginger, and dried grass. This has picked up plenty of flavour and some spice from the wood.

Finish: Good length, warm and drying.

Reserva / 10 Year Old

Nose: Quite fruity to start - dark fruit, damson & plum. A wine-like blackcurrant note, developing to blackcurrant jelly or undiluted Ribena. Creamy vanilla, toffee and spice notes (clove, cinnamon), some evident oak as the aromas open up.

Palate: Spicy initial attack, then luscious mouth-coating smooth oak and fruity flavours from the nose wash over the tastebuds. The creamy vanilla and dusty cinnamon dominate the mid-palate.

Finish: Very good length, warm and drying with residual spices as the oak fades.
