Nose

Malty with a yeasty tang. A mix of herbs and honey, like a mead. A bit sugary. Orange squash.

Palate

Sweet even candylike. Crystallised violets. Gets minty. Nice fresh feel but all in a piece.

Soft, (too) sweet and rather bland.

A heavy style. Lacks elegance and complexity. Even a sweet tooth might be disappointed.
